

Cricket Fixed Odds Rules – Version 20-09-2013

- 1. Our Fixed Odds betting markets are currently being offered to a small group of clients who specifically requested them. We hope to offer these new markets to all clients in the very near future.*
- 2. SportsSpread reserves the right to accept or decline a bet.*
- 3. Where a customer's bet is placed on what are blatantly incorrect odds, SportsSpread reserves the right to re-book that bet at the correct odds. In this situation SportsSpread will make every effort to contact the customer who will have the choice to (i) have the bet in question booked at the correct price or (ii) have the bet voided. If it is not possible to contact the customer that bet will be re-booked at the correct price.*
- 4. Whilst we try to ensure that the odds displayed are current, the nature of live betting means that, from time to time, these will differ from those available at the time you call to place a bet. The odds confirmed to you at the time of bet acceptance will determine settlement.*
- 5. Where there is evidence of any match fixing, we reserve the right to make bets void or withhold settlements pending the outcome of any subsequent investigation.*
- 6. SportsSpread cannot allow for mistakes nor accept responsibility for any errors or omissions in respect of displaying of prices, despite our every effort to ensure total accuracy. We reserve the right to correct obvious errors (Example: bets struck on a non-live market after the event has started or on an obviously incorrect price).*
- 7. SportsSpread reserves the right to close a customer's account at any time on notice to you without affecting any outstanding bets.*

Cricket Fixed Odds Rules - Twenty 20 Matches – Version 20-09-2013

1. *Over team runs bets – In the event of a tie, all bets will be void regardless of the fact that the first innings may have already been completed. Therefore any bet placed on the first innings team runs will not be fully settled until the finish of the match.*
2. *If a match is abandoned then all bets will be void.*
3. *If the number of overs is reduced due to a delay then all bets on that innings will be void. We may or may not offer new markets on the runs under the revised number of overs. In the event of a tie all bets will be void.*
4. *Pre match runs bets only stand on the team batting first. All bets on the team batting second are void. In the event of a tie or abandonment all bets will be void*
5. *First 5 overs runs bets (or any other incremental overs markets) – In the event of a tie all bets will be void regardless of the fact that the first 5 overs of the innings may have been already completed. Therefore any bet placed on the first 5 overs runs will not be fully settled until the conclusion of the match. If a side happens to win the match within the first 5 overs then their score will be counted as such. If there is an interruption within the first 5 overs as long as the first 5 overs are completed following the interruption then all bets continue to stand.*
6. *Outright/Match bets - In the event of a tie or an abandoned match where there is no official result, all bets will be void. If the match is shortened, bets will be settled where there is an official result as determined by the relevant governing body under the competition rules. A 'bowl off' to determine the result of a match will not count, e.g. Tie or abandoned rules will apply.*

Cricket Fixed Odds Rules - One Day Matches – Version 20-09-2013

1. *Limited over team runs bets – In the event of a tie, all bets will be void regardless of the fact that the first innings may have been already completed, therefore any bet placed on first innings team runs will not be fully settled until the finish of the match.*
2. *If a match is abandoned then all bets will be void.*
3. *If the number of overs is reduced due to a delay then all bets on that innings will be void. We may or may not then offer new markets on the runs under the revised number of overs. In the event of a tie all bets will be void.*
4. *Pre match runs bets only stand on the team batting first. All bets on the team batting second are void. In the event of a tie or abandonment all bets will be void.*
5. *First 15 overs runs bets (or any other incremental overs markets e.g. 1st 25 overs) – In the event of a tie all bets will be void regardless of the fact that the first 15 overs of the innings may have been already completed. Therefore any bet placed on the first 15 overs will not be fully settled until the conclusion of the match. If a side happens to win the match within the first 15 overs then their score will be counted as such. If there is an interruption within the first 15 overs as long as the first 15 overs are completed following the stoppage then all bets continue to stand.*
6. *Outright/Match bets - In the event of a tie or an abandoned match where there is no official result, all bets will be void. If the match is shortened, bets will be settled where there is an official result as determined by the relevant governing body under the competition rules. A 'bowl off' to determine the result of a match will not count, e.g. Tie or abandoned rules will apply*
